


BEDDOW ADDITION

BELLEFONTAINE



Lots from 22 to 25 inclusive are subdivision of a block 12.7 poles South, 15 poles East and 11.8 poles North each lot being 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet and with lines parallel to Water Street. — The lots above represented are part of the N.E. gr. of Sec. 34, T4, M.R.S. Survey commenced at a stone planted at Sides of S.W. Corner and N.W. Corner of Water St. Water St. is S.89°E and 60 feet wide. South alley is also S.89°E. 15 feet wide cross alleys are at right angles with Water St. and 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet wide. Lots No 1-7 were laid out by D. Hopkins Dec 20th 1848 and are 100 ft front by 200 back. Lots from 8 to 21 are 50 ft front by 247 back surveyed and platted Dec 1, 1849.

Lots are laid on a base line N.14°E. Corresponding to the Old town Street and alleys are parallel to or at right angles with line lots No 1-2-3 and 4 are 55 feet front by 220 back. Lot no 5 is 55 feet N 59 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E and W 100 ft. North Alley is 10 ft wide. Stone planted at the South East corner of lot No 5 10 ft wide West of lot marked with a diagonal lines is a Side-walk Madison Street and the alley extended out of the Old town retain their width and course surveyed and platted April 24th and 29th 1850

Before me a Notary Public within and for said County personally came Benjamin Stanton and Nancy his wife of the County of Logan and State of Ohio and acknowledge the annexed plat and survey of the Northern Addition to Bellefontaine to be their voluntary act and deed for the purposes there in set forth and hereby dedicate the streets and alleys there in set forth to the public as public streets and highways and the said Nancy having been examined by me separate and apart from her said husband and the said plat and survey having been explained and there object made known to her by me she acknowledged the same to be her act and deed and relinquishes all right of dower there in and that she is still satisfied therewith.
