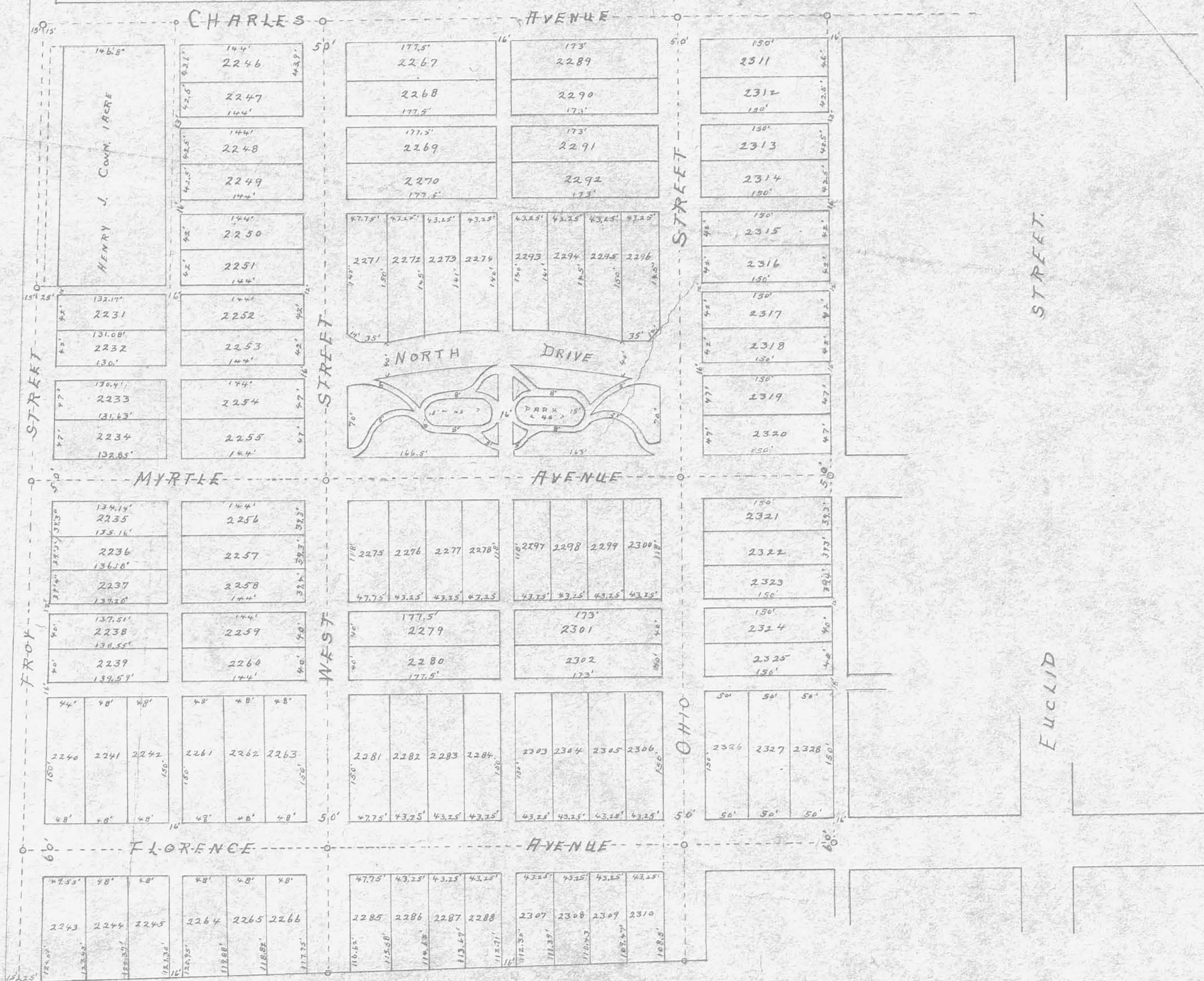


MC CRACKEN'S ADDITION

BELLEFONTAINE

Being an allotment of the North W. 1/4 of Frac. Sec 35 T4 R 14 M. R. S.

Surveyors Certificate: I the undersigned Surveyor do hereby certify that the annexed plat is a correct representation of J. C. McCracken's 2nd Addition to Bellefontaine, Ohio as surveyed and laid out by me under the direction of the proprietor on the 2nd to the 12th day of April A.D. 1894. The following bearings and distances designate the boundaries of the said allotment, Commencing at the N.W. Corner of McCracken's first Addition, Thence S 3° 30' W 943.5 feet along the West line thereof to the North line of Florence Avenue, Thence N 86° 30' W with it 200 feet, Thence S 3° 30' W 168 1/2 feet to J. C. McCracken's South line, Thence N. 87° 42' W with said line 744.5 feet to the center of North Troy Street, Thence with said Street, N. 4° 32' E 820 feet to a corner S.W. corner of one acre lot land, Thence S 86° 50' E 146.9 feet, Thence with the East line of said lot N 4° 32' E 297 feet to the center of Charles Street, Thence with said center line N 86° 50' W 769 feet to the place of beginning and containing 22 3/4 acres. All lots, streets and alleylines are parallel to or at right angles with Ohio Street or Florence Avenue, except those bounded by North West and South boundary lines to Ohio Street which said lots have each a boundary out of parallel. All lot, street and alley lines are marked in feet and tenths on the lines thereof. The Boundary lines of the Addition are designated by the letters A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, A. Monuments are placed at the intersection of streets are designated by small circles. Complete distances from center to center of Monumented points marked on the map in red ink on the lines thereof. All bearings are marked magnetically.

Dedication: I James C. McCracken proprietor do hereby certify that the annexed plat is a true representation of land as laid out under my direction as McCracken's 2nd Addition to Bellefontaine, Ohio surveyed and plotted by Wilbur A. Sinn Surveyor, in April A.D. 1894. Said Addition is located as set forth in the Surveyors Certificate as is shown on the annexed plat and consists of Ninety Eight (98) lot numbered from 2231 to 2328 inclusive, together with the streets, alleys and park as shown on the plat. The length and width of all streets and alleys are as represented by the figures marked on the lines thereof as described in the Surveyors Certificate. The streets and alleys and ground for park purposes contained in the above described Addition as laid out are each dedicated to the public use forever to be used and held for the purposes as set forth.
