

An ordinance to provide for the annexation of Contiguous Territory

Sec 1

Be it ordained by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Bellecenter that all the territory contiguous to said Village contained within the following limits and not already embraced within the Corporate limits of the said Village be and the same is hereby annexed to and made part of the said Village and Municipal Corporation namely. Beginning in the marsh road at the N.E. corner of Bergin's land thence on the N line of Bergin's land to Wylie S 80 1/2° W 231 poles crossing the rail road at 45. The corner between Torrance & Wylie at 134.4. a swale at 180 poles, to NW corner, to Wylie land. Thence S 9 1/2° E 130 poles, on the W of Wylie. Hinkle & Ramsey & across M.L. Anderson's land to R.R. Thence South 34° E through lands of Anderson Mains Wright & Lunt to junction in mill race & Branch or ditch, thence N 80 1/2° E 147 poles on the S. line of Lambert & Richardson & Stebbins crossing the Northward & Roundhead pike at 58 1/2 poles & passing through the S.E. corner of Richardson's land at 110 poles to the marsh road; thence with the center of the ^{said} road N 9 1/2° W 236 poles, on the east line of lands of Steele Gossard, Johnson & Dickler & Bergin, A Bridge at 16 Ramsey's line at 114. Gossard corner at 136. B Pike at 178 a run SE at 210. poles &c to the beginning.

Be it further ordained, that application be made by Petition to the Commissioners of Logan County to annex and cause to be annexed to said Village of

Bellevue the contiguous territory included
within the limits and bounds described
in the preceding section, and that

To the Commissioners of Logan County, Ohio

Under an ordinance passed by the incorporated Village of Bellecenter on the 3 day of June 1874. the contiguous territory hereinafter described was authorized to be annexed to said Village. In pursuance of which ordinance the said incorporated Village hereby makes application to your Board to annex said Contiguous territory thereto the same being described as follows, "All the territory contiguous to said Village contained within the following limits and not already embraced within the Corporate limits of said town an accurate plat of which is hereto attached and made part of this application as follows

Beginning in the Marsh road at the N.E. corner of S H Berget's land Thence on the N line of Berget Torrence and Wiley S. 80° E. $22\frac{1}{4}$ Poles crossing the R.R. at 45 the corner between Torrence and Wiley at 124 4 a Swale at 180 poles to N.W. corner to Wileys land Thence S 9° E 150 poles on the W of Wileys Hinkle & Ramsey and a cross M. L. Andersons land to the R.R. Thence S 39° E through lands of Anderson Mains Wright and Lambert to junction in Race and Branch or ditch Thence N 80° E 147 poles on the S. line of Lambert Richardson and Steele crossing the Northwood & Roundhead pike at $59\frac{1}{2}$ poles & passing the S.E. corner to Richardsons land at 110 poles to the Marsh Road Thence with the center of said Road N 9° W 236 poles on

the E line of lands of Steele, Gossard, Johnson, Sickles, and Berget. a Bridge at 16, Ramsey lane at 114, Gossards cor at 136 Bellecentre pike at 178 a new Street at 210 poles &c to the Beginning

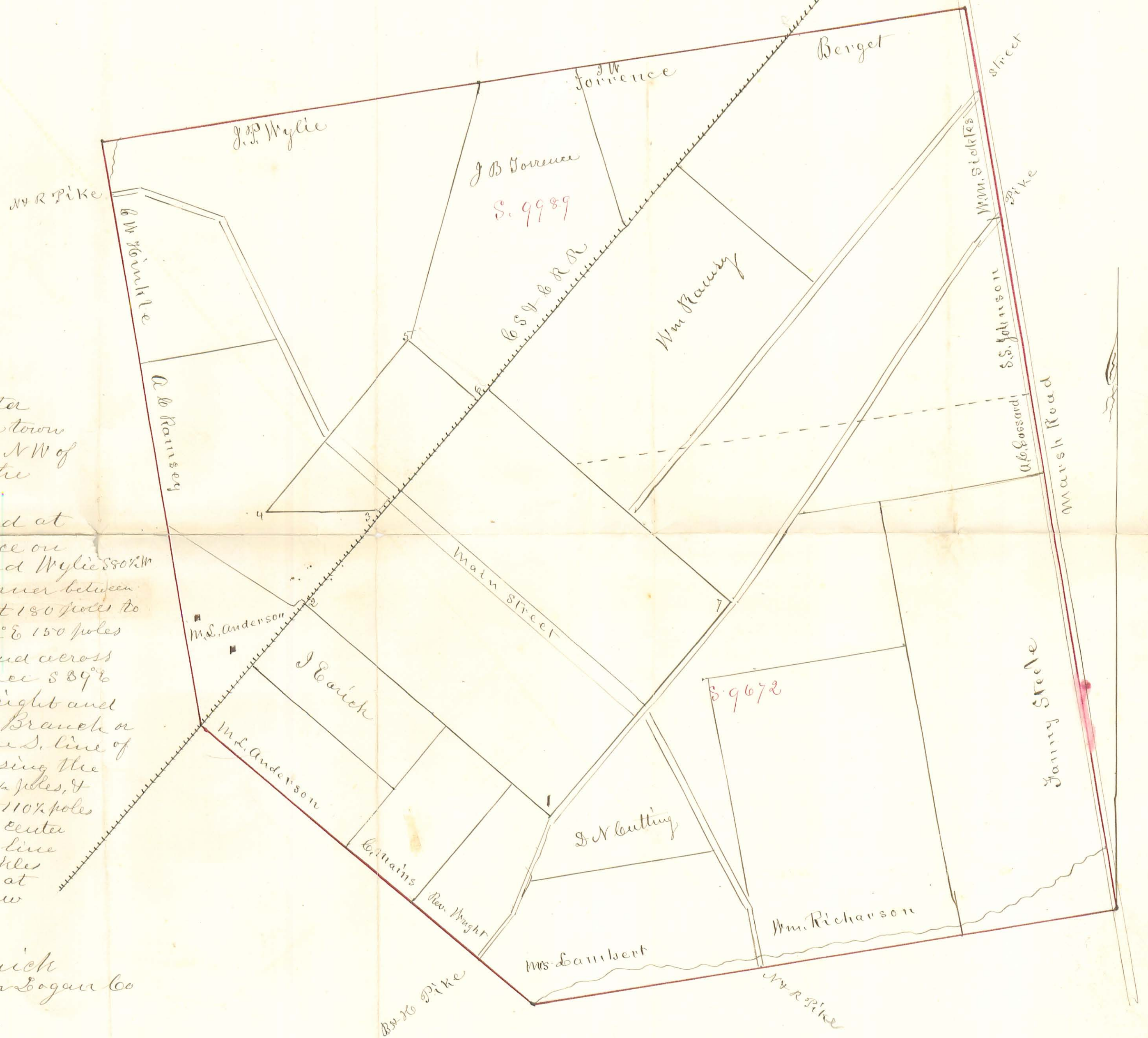
The annexed Plat represents the village of Bellecenta 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, & 7 the old or original town and additions, the additions being NW of the R.R. The red line represents the proposed municipal limits viz.

Beginning on the Marsh Road at the NW corner to Bergert's land. Thence on the N. line of Bergert, Torrence and Wylie S 30° W 22 1/4 poles, crossing the R.R. at 45, the corner between Torrence and Wylie at 124 1/2, a Swale at 180 poles to NW cor. to Wylie's land. Thence S 9 1/2° E 150 poles on the W. of Wylie, Hinkle & Ramsey and across M.L. Anderson's land to the R.R. Thence S 39° E through lands of Anderson, Mains, Wright and Lambert to junction of Race and Branch a ditch, Thence N 80 1/2° E 147 poles, on the S. line of Lambert, Richardson and Steele, crossing the Northwood & Roundhead Pike at 68 1/2 poles, & passing the SE cor. to Richardson's land at 110 poles to the Marsh Road. Thence with the center of said Road N 9 1/4° W 236 poles, on the E. line of lands of Steele, Gossard, Johnson, Pickles & Bergert, a Bridge at 16, Ramsey's land at 114, Gossard's cor. at 136, R. Pike at 178, a new Street at 210 pole &c to the Beginning.

Sec-1 An ordinance to annex certain territory to the Incorporated Village of Belle Centre
Be it ordained by the Council of the incorporated village of Belle Centre
that the following described territory be and the same is hereby authorized
to be annexed to the incorporated village of Belle Centre Logan County
to wit Commencing at the North West Corner of lot No 4 of the
original Town of Belle Centre Thence North 37° East 1306 feet more or less to the
North west Corner of Lot No 16 of ^{Wm} Ramsays addition to said village thence South
53° East 754 feet more or less to a point South 53° East 50 feet distant from
the North East Corner of Lot No 31 of Ramsays said addition thence South
37° West with the East line of Centre Street of said Ramsays addition 541
feet more or less to a point opposite the North East Corner of lot No 35
of said addition 2nd South 53° East 50 feet thence from thence South 53° East to a
point in the East side of The Kenton road thence with said road to a point
opposite the North East Corner of Lot No 16 of the original town of Belle
Centre and 60 feet South 53° East thence from thence with the South side of the
North Border alley of said village 1310 feet more or less to the Beginning

The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment Jno Rosebrook Henry Kelly and C.C. Cookston being present and proceeded with business as follows, to wit

In the matter of the annexation of territory to the village of Belle Centre

This being the day fixed by the County Commissioners to hear the petition for the annexation of certain territory to said incorporated village and all evidence and remonstrances against the same and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that there are no objection to said annexation, that the annexation of said territory is proper and reasonable, and that the proceedings in relation to said annexation have been in all respects according to Law, it is ordered by unanimous agreement of the Board, that the prayer of the petition be granted and that the territory therein described as sought to be annexed to said incorporated village be and hereafter shall be included in, and constitute a part of said incorporated village

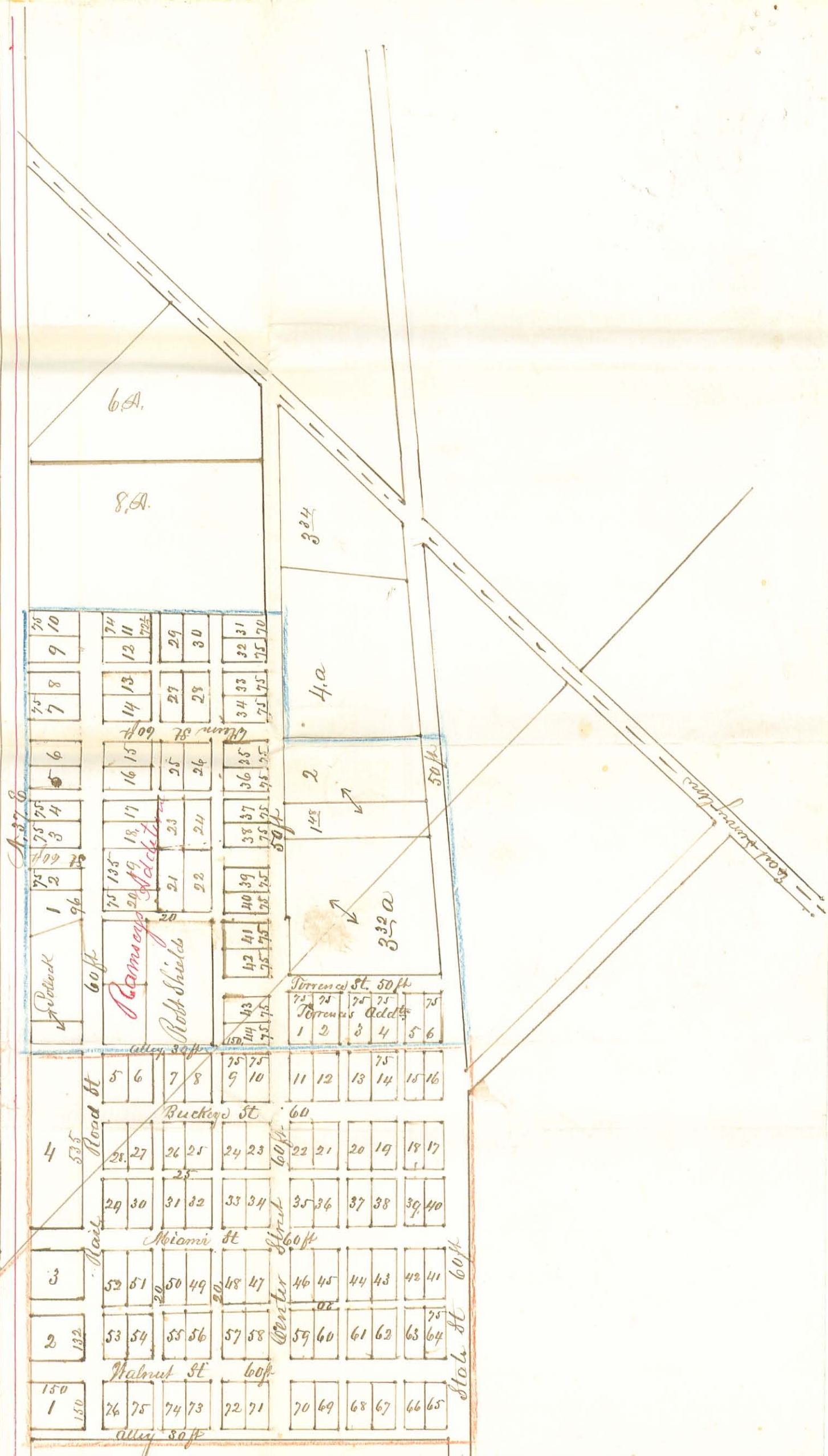

Territory sought to be annexed

To the Honorable Board of Commissioners of Logan County Ohio.
Gentlemen

We the undersigned adult freeholders residing on the territory here-
inafter described and adjacent to the Incorporated Village of Belle Center in Richland
Township in said County of Logan ask and pray your Honorable Board to cause said
territory to be annexed to the Corporation of said Village as provided in Chapter 5 of the Revised
Statutes of said State of Ohio, and we herein and hereby authorize Joseph J. McConnell to act as
the Agent of the petitioners in securing such annexation. Said territory is described as follows. Being
parts of Original Virginia Military Surveys Nos. 9972 and 9989, in said Township of Richland,
Beginning at a Stake at the N.W. Corner of Sewall Corns lot of 44¹/₄ of an acre at the N.E. corner of
Scotts heirs land and in the South line of Mrs McClures land in O.V.M. Survey No 9989, thence
with the East line of said Scotts heirs land S. 9° E. 25 chains crossing the Roundhead ditch at 34¹/₂
chains, and the Siggitt Ditch at 6³/₄ chains to a Stake at the S. E. corner of said Scotts land in the
line between said Surveys 9989 & 9972, thence continuing same course 6³/₄ chains into the
land of Mr. L. Anderson in said Survey 9972 to a Stake from which the S.W. corner of said Ande-
sons barn bears S. 34¹/₄° E. 32 links, thence S. 52° 50' E. 14¹/₂ chains (passing through the S.W. sharp of
said barn) to the center of the O. B. & N. R. Road, thence continuing same course and with the
South line of Canicks addition to said Village, and the South line of Jacob Caricks tract of
72¹/₂ acres 2¹/₂ chains to the center of the Kenton pike, thence with the center of said pike
N. 32¹/₂° E. 2¹/₂ chains to the corner between Samuel Lamberts Deed and Amelia A. Wolleys 6³/₄ acres
thence with the South line of said Wolleys 14¹/₂ chains and the S.W. line of Sarah E. Wolleys 2¹/₂ acres
S. 83° 20' E. 6¹/₂ chains to the corner between said Wolley & Lambert in the Northwood Pike,
thence N. 87¹/₄° E. 14¹/₂ chains through the land of Minor Harrod and continuing same course
9¹/₂ chains through the land of John Maggior to a Stake in a County road, in the East line of
said Survey No 9972, thence with said line & Road N. 7° 10' W. 29¹/₂ chains crossing the White town
at 1¹/₂ chains and the middle of an alley of 17¹/₂ chains to the East corner between said Surveys
9972 & 9989, thence with the said road and the Marsh pike the East line of Survey 9989 N. 8° 10'

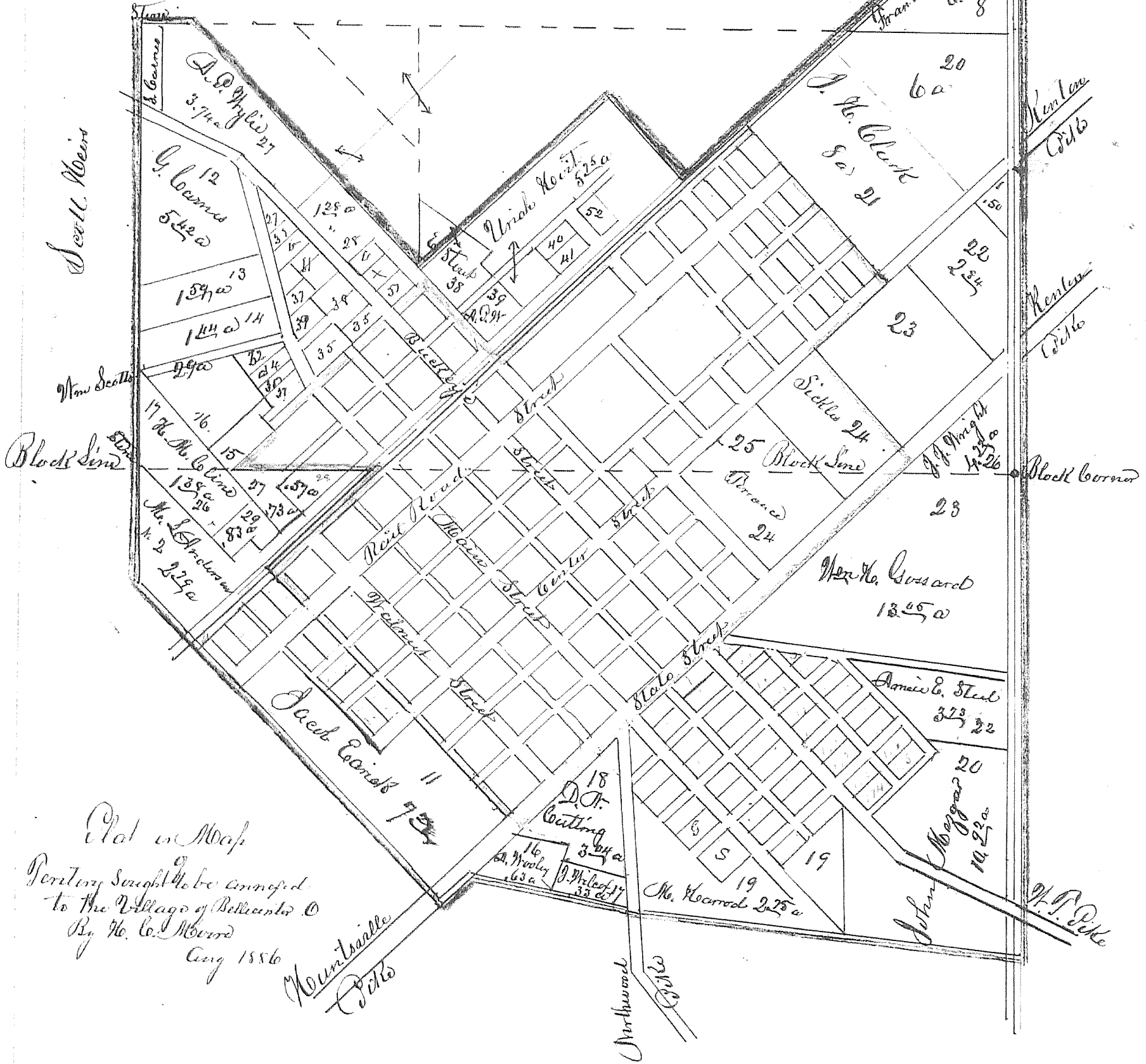
